

## Nebraska State Grange Educational Aid Scholarship

### Requirements:

1. Must be a high school graduate.
2. Must be a 4<sup>th</sup> degree member for a year or a child/grandchild of a Grange member.
3. Must actually be enrolled in a college or vocational school.
4. First time applicants must have at least a 2.0 (C) cumulative grade point average.
5. To be eligible to reapply for the scholarship, applicants are required to have a 3.0 (B) cumulative grade point average.
6. The scholarship will be \$500 with one half payable to college at the beginning of the fall semester, and one half at the beginning of the spring semester, with consideration by the committee in case of various type schools. In case of withdrawal or default by the recipient, another applicant will be considered.
7. Recipients are required to communicate back to the Nebraska State Grange at the annual meeting on the progress they are making toward their goal.
8. Credit will be given for Grange participation, community, church and school activities.
9. Preference will be given for persons enrolling in agriculture or related fields, and first time applicants.
10. Certified grade transcripts must accompany application.
11. Applications must be received by MARCH 15. Winners will be announced by April 15. Additional scholarship forms may be obtained from the State Secretary or from the Nebraska State Grange website: [nebraskastategrange.org](http://nebraskastategrange.org).
12. Selection of the winner will be made by the Nebraska State Grange Executive Committee. Decision of the committee is final.
13. Enclose a photo of yourself with the application Photo will be used for publicity purpose and will not be returned.

Make sure you have completed all information on application and include the required photo and essay.
